Choosing a Confirmation Saint

Your name was spoken out loud on the day of your Baptism and it became part of your identity as a son or daughter of God and a member of the Catholic Church. A great deal of thought went into your parents' choice in naming you. You may be named after a relative, a special family friend, or a saint your parents greatly admire. Now, you have the opportunity to choose a Saint name for Confirmation. This Saint should be someone you admire and want to imitate in your life of faith. You are also choosing this Saint to be your special intercessor throughout your life. As you think and pray about which Saint you want to choose for your Confirmation name, here are some questions for you to think about:

- What draws you to this saint?
- What virtues do they have that you want to imitate?
- What strikes you most about their life?

Saint Project Guidelines:

<u>Poster:</u> You are going to be creating an informative poster (8 ½ x 11-no bigger than a standard size piece of paper-must be on hard cardstock or backed on construction paper, please keep project to size indicated with nothing hanging off the paper) about your chosen Confirmation Saint. Each student will create their own presentation and each student be researching your own Saint. Be creative with how your poster is organized.

On your poster you **must** include the following information:

- * Saint Name (Title)
- * Feast Day of your Saint
- * What they are the Patron of (Patron Saint of)
- * Picture of your saint (can be drawn or printed off computer)
- * Why are they a saint? –(How did they carry out the acts of Christ and live each day with love. What miracles did they perform?)
- * Information about their life (when were they born, when did they pass away, family information, any other interesting information)
- * Personal Prayer of your Patron Saint
- * Your poster should be colored and neatly decorated/presented

<u>Reflection:</u> Upon completing your poster, you will also be required to write a **one page reflection (at least 5 paragraphs)** on your project. The reflection must be typed 12pt font and **must be attached to the back of your poster.** In your reflection, you may choose to use some of the following ideas to help guide you:

- * Why you chose the Saint you chose (what importance or significance does the Saint have for you)
- * What you learned about your Saint that surprised or impressed you about them or their life
- * How your Saint has inspired you to do better or be a better person
- * What did you learn or take away from this assignment what did you enjoy the most
